This recent trip to Myanmar was both deeply fulfilling and humbling. Though the terrain and journey were not always easy, being there in person to spend time with our BRAVE Myanmar Country Director, the team, and the communities we serve was deeply meaningful.

Part of this trip was also a journey of accountability and stewardship, as funds raised for the BRAVE Myanmar Earthquake Relief efforts last year were used to help rebuild five homes on water for affected families. Visiting these families, hearing their stories, and witnessing their resilience deeply impacted us.

During the trip, we also attended the graduation of Grace Preschool and the IBC Summer Camp, conducted two days of leaders' training, visited Bible seminaries, and spent time encouraging and praying with pastors and Bible school students. These moments reminded us that ministry is not just about projects completed, but lives strengthened, relationships built, and the love of Christ made tangible through presence and compassion.

One of the highlights of the trip was celebrating the Graduation of Grace Preschool and Summer Camp. What began in 2022 with just 14 students has grown into a ministry impacting hundreds of children and families. Standing before more than 800 parents, relatives, teachers, volunteers, and community members, we were overwhelmed by God's faithfulness. Through the children, doors have been opened to serve and build relationships with the wider community.

Being in Myanmar reminded us why Grace Preschool, Grace Home and Joy Home are so important. Many children come from vulnerable backgrounds, while others have families who struggle to provide for them. These ministries are more than schools and homes - they are places of safety, belonging, discipleship, and hope. Every lesson, meal, prayer, and act of love helps shape a child's future and creates opportunities for entire families to encounter the love of Christ.

One of the highlights of the trip was visiting the families whose homes were rebuilt after the 2025 earthquake. Reaching these communities required a long journey by boat across the lake, followed by smaller rowed boats into remote villages. As we travelled through the waterways, we were reminded of both the beauty of the region and the challenges many families face each day. The journey gave us a deeper appreciation of the resilience of these communities.

RESTORING HOPE AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE



Meeting the families and hearing their stories was deeply moving. Several shared that after losing their homes in the earthquake, they never imagined they would have a place to call home again. Through God's provision and the generosity of BRAVE Ministry supporters, hope has been restored. These rebuilt homes represent more than shelter - they provide security, dignity, and the opportunity for families to rebuild their future.

SEEING THE NEED AND SHARING THE HOPE



We visited Grace Preschool, Grace Home, and a remote mountain community. While encouraged by the ministry's impact, we were reminded of the significant needs that remain. Years of frequent flooding have weakened parts of the preschool and home, highlighting the need for repairs and future rebuilding to provide a safe and secure environment for the children. We met children whose families could no longer care for them and elderly villagers who never had the opportunity to receive an education. Yet many expressed gratitude that their children now have access to education and the opportunity to dream of a different future.

STRENGTHENED IN HIS PRESENCE

At Innlay Baptist Church, we joined local believers in worship and fellowship. Though the setup was simple, the congregation worshipped wholeheartedly, singing with sincerity and joy. God's presence was deeply tangible as the church gathered to seek Him together.

During ministry time, people responded for prayer, carrying burdens, hurts, and hopes for healing. As we prayed with them, many were deeply touched by God's love and encouragement. It was a powerful reminder that God continues to strengthen His people and faithfully work in hearts across Myanmar.



WALKING TOGETHER IN GOD'S CALLING



Over two days, pastors, teachers, ministry workers, and volunteers gathered for leadership training focused on walking closely with God and faithfully serving in the places He has called them. While the teaching was meaningful, the greatest impact came during ministry time, where broken relationships were restored, forgiveness was extended, and unity was strengthened. We witnessed God bringing healing and reconciliation among leaders who continue to serve faithfully despite many challenges.



REACHING MYANMAR THROUGH MYANMAR LEADERS



During visits to seminaries and ministry training schools, we discovered that Myanmar has many well-trained and passionate pastors and leaders. The greatest need is often not more leaders, but greater support and resources to help them reach their own people. Across Myanmar's many ethnic groups, local missionaries travel long distances, often in difficult conditions, to share the Gospel with communities that may otherwise never hear it.

WHAT GOD SHOWED US

Throughout this trip, three themes stood out. First, children are often the bridge to families and communities. Second, practical acts of compassion create opportunities for lasting relationships and Gospel witness. Third, Myanmar's future will be shaped by faithful local leaders reaching their own people. These lessons continue to shape how BRAVE Ministry partners with communities and leaders across Myanmar.



We return from Myanmar with grateful hearts and renewed vision. While the needs remain great, we are encouraged by the faithfulness of local leaders, the resilience of communities, and the opportunities God continues to open. As we move forward, we remain committed to partnering with local believers to fulfill the Great Commandment and the Great Commission—loving God, loving others, making disciples, and bringing the hope of Christ to future generations.
