OUTREACH

- 504 individuals reached
- 73 families received food aid
- 310 kg of rice distributed
- 4 families received medical assistance

DISCIPLESHIP

- 11 pastors & leaders engaged across 4 partner churches
- 2 training sessions conducted, equipping 35 leaders
- Active discipleship through weekly groups and personal mentoring (youth, communities, and women's prison)

EDUCATION

- 36 students attending 6 days/ week at our Learning Centre
- 3 University sponsorships (Students in Engineering, Linguistics & Translation, and Social Work)

BRAVE COMMUNITY OUTREACH

We continue to serve communities through compassion, outreach, and practical support. Among the slum community, families received food aid, medical assistance, and financial support during times of need. During Khmer New Year, multiple communities were reached through celebrations that gathered families together, creating meaningful opportunities for connection and encouragement. Additional support was provided to vulnerable families, including essential supplies for young children and medical help. Through these efforts, we are grateful to meet both practical and spiritual needs, bringing hope and care to the communities we serve.



BRAVE DISCIPLESHIP



Across Cambodia, our discipleship work continues to grow through both group and personal engagement. Regular Bible studies, home groups, youth gatherings, and prison ministry create consistent spaces for spiritual growth, community, and encouragement.

At the same time, leaders are intentionally walking with individuals through personal discipleship and mentoring, helping them grow deeper in their faith. Together, these efforts reflect a strong and ongoing commitment to raising believers who are grounded in the Word and living it out in their daily lives.

BRAVE EDUCATION - RAISING FUTURE LEADERS

BRAVE Education continues to invest in the next generation through both foundational learning and higher education support. The Chhuk Learning Centre currently serves 36 registered students, providing a consistent environment for growth and development.

In addition, three students are being supported through university sponsorships in Engineering, Linguistics and Translation, and Social Work—one of whom, Povleak, achieved top 5 in his first year. Together, a total of 39 students are being equipped and empowered through education, raising up future leaders with both knowledge and purpose.

Every two months, our team carries out community outreach by distributing small care packs at local markets, each containing snacks and government-approved Gospel tracts provided by the Myanmar Baptist Convention. Through this simple yet meaningful initiative, we have so far visited two markets and reached over 5,000 people. These moments create natural opportunities to share God's love in practical ways, sowing seeds of hope and truth within the community.

TRAINING AND EQUIPPING MINISTERS, LEADERS, AND TEACHERS

In February and March, Brave Myanmar equipped both leaders and ministry teams through two focused trainings. A 2-day Leadership Training on “Altar Prayer” brought together 25 pastors and leaders, leading to renewed hunger for God, repentance, and stronger unity.

This was followed by a Teachers and Volunteers Training preparing 24 participants for the upcoming Summer Camp, strengthening both their spiritual foundation and practical teaching skills. With over 180 children expected, these trainings have been key in raising a ready and spiritually grounded team to impact the next generation



BRAVE MYANMAR SUMMER CAMP



Brave Myanmar's Summer Camp 2026 marks its third year of impacting children and youth through a 3-month program (March–May), reaching over 250 children across Grace Preschool and Joy Home Education Center. Through academic support, life skills, and Christ-centered teaching alongside daily routines, mentoring, prayer, and worship, the children are growing in confidence and experiencing both emotional and spiritual encouragement. A key highlight was the Good Friday outreach, where about 50 children and 150 parents gathered to hear the Gospel and watch the Jesus Movie, creating meaningful opportunities to reach families with the love of Christ. We thank God for the continued impact and appreciate your prayers as the camp continues.

TIME WITH BRAVE TEAM AND MINISTRY PARTNERS

In March, we spent time with our BRAVE staff and team to encourage and strengthen them, while navigating a leadership transition as our Country Directors step into a new season, with Melinda and Ps Samuel taking on this role. We honour and thank them for their faithful service and vital role over the years, and bless them as they move forward.

We connected with volunteers from Nations Church Phnom Penh, and visited Kg Speu province (a church plant of Nations Church) to explore potential partnerships for outreach.



PREACHING AT NATIONS CHURCH, CVCC AND RCC

Pastor Samuel recently had the opportunity to minister across several churches, including Nations Church (Phnom Penh), Covenant Vision Christian Church and Revival Centre Church. At each location, he brought a timely and life-giving message centered on “*Living the Resurrection*” from Romans 6. The message called believers not just to remember the resurrection of Christ, but to actively live in its reality - walking in freedom, renewed identity, and victory over sin. We are encouraged to see how the Word is bearing fruit across different communities, strengthening believers and igniting fresh faith.



UPCOMING MINISTRY MOVEMENTS - MYANMAR, CAMBODIA, AND SINGAPORE

Myanmar | 14–21 May

We will be travelling across Yangon, Innlay and Taunggyi, preaching at services, ministering at a summer camp graduation, visiting villages and families supported by BRAVE Ministry, conducting 2 days of leaders training, and spending time with pastors, Bible School students, and children's ministries.

Singapore | 1–6 June

We will be welcoming a small team from Nations Church (Phnom Penh) who will be in Singapore for a YWAM creative conference. During their time here, we'll be gathering with them to encourage, refresh, and build deeper fellowship.

Cambodia | 23–30 June & 27 Aug–3 Sept

During these trips, we will be meeting with our staff to strengthen and encourage them, while providing oversight for the work and ongoing projects. This comes at a key moment as our current Country Directors step into a new season and we navigate a leadership transition.

Singapore | 4–7 Sept

We will be hosting a small group of medical students from Phnom Penh to attend the Intentional Disciple Making Church Conference (IDMC). Our desire is to create space to encourage and strengthen them during this time.
