A SEASON OF REFOCUSING



This has been a season of transition and refocusing for BRAVE Cambodia. As we prayerfully seek God for what He has entrusted to us in this next season, we sense Him leading us to go deeper and focus our efforts where we can journey closely with people and communities.

Our two main areas of focus will be Chouk Va Mouy in Phnom Penh and Chhuk in Kampot. Through discipleship, education, community development and practical expressions of love, our desire is to build meaningful relationships and walk faithfully with these communities for the long term.

CHOUK VA MOUY COMMUNITY

Over the past few months, as we continued serving in Chouk Va Mouy, we noticed many children with limited opportunities to attend school or receive education. God placed on our hearts to respond to this need, and we began a new English class three times a week, taught by a Bible school student.

Using Christian based learning materials, the children are gaining practical English skills while also having the opportunity to hear the Gospel and learn about the love of Jesus. Our prayer is that this simple classroom will open doors for us to journey with the children and their families, bringing hope and pointing them to Christ.



CHHUK COMMUNITY



The rainy season in Chhuk often makes the journey to the Learning Centre difficult, especially for students who live far away and can only walk or cycle to class. Yet despite the rain and challenging roads, our children continue to show up faithfully each day, eager to learn and grow.



That same faithfulness extends beyond the classroom. Pastor PenRa continues to visit those who are unable to come to church, spending time studying God's Word, praying and discipling them in their homes. It is a simple but beautiful reminder that discipleship is about going to where people are and faithfully walking alongside them.

OUR NEW JOY PRESCHOOL

From 2024 to 2026, we held summer camps for children in our community, and year by year, God helped us build trust and relationships with local families. As we saw the growing needs of the children, and as God provided additional teachers from Grace Preschool, who also have government-recognized preschool teaching certificates, we prayerfully felt led to start Joy Preschool.

We began with only 5 students, but by God's grace, we have now grown to 21 students. We believe these children are precious lives entrusted to our care, and our prayer is that Joy Preschool will be a place where they can learn, grow, and experience God's love through our care and service. All glory belongs to God for what He has done and continues to do.



HOME VISITS AND PASTORAL CARE

This quarter, our team conducted home visits and hospital visits for families and staff connected to our ministry. These visits allowed us to better understand the realities many of our families face, and gave us the opportunity to encourage them, pray together, and offer practical support during difficult seasons.

Several families, parents, and staff members experienced health challenges this quarter. Through both home and hospital visits, our team was able to sit with them, listen to their needs, and remind them that they are not alone. We are grateful for the chance to walk alongside our families beyond the classroom, and thankful for God's faithfulness through every visit.



GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS AND PRESCHOOLS SUPPORT



Many villages in Myanmar continue to suffer from the ongoing civil war, with schools in conflict-affected areas closed for the past four to five years. For this outreach, we intentionally selected government schools and preschools that have operated peacefully over the past year but still face shortages of basic educational resources and access to safe drinking water.

The water filtration clay pots we distributed will provide safer drinking water for students and teachers each day, while the teaching aids will help preschool teachers run more engaging classroom activities for young children. School principals, teachers, and local communities warmly welcomed our team and expressed their heartfelt appreciation.

STUDENT CARE SUPPORT



We provided essential school supplies to 66 children across our Grace Preschool, Grace Home and Joy Preschool in Myanmar. Each child received a school uniform, backpack, slippers, umbrella and water bottle. Our teachers and staff were also blessed with umbrellas and water bottles. These essential items help our children stay dry, safe and prepared for school throughout Myanmar's heavy monsoon season.



More than meeting practical needs, this project was an expression of Christ's love to the children, their families and our dedicated staff. We thank God for the opportunity to bring joy, dignity and encouragement to our community through practical care and support.
