OUTREACH TO FAMILIES DISPLACED BY BORDER CONFLICT

As a small local ministry with limited resources, we have been purposefully focusing our response efforts on displaced families that have fled the frontlines and have fallen through the gaps of broader NGO support.

We have also directed our outreach efforts through our existing partnerships with provincial pastors who are not just able to provide essential basic needs, but are also able to share the gospel and to return more than once, so as to continue building relationships and meaningful connections.



VIETNAMESE COMMUNITY OUTREACH



OUTREACH TO FAMILIES DISPLACED BY BORDER CONFLICT

We have had the privilege of providing more than 200 families with at least 10 kgs of rice, other food, hygiene and necessary items.

Most importantly, each of them have heard the Good News of Jesus Christ, received a gospel booklet and prayer for those who are open. For many, it was the first time hearing about Jesus or having the gospel shared with them. We believe that God is using this circumstance to bring the hope and truth of the gospel to people and places previously unreached.



NEW PASTOR APPOINTED AT KAMPONG THOM COMMUNITY CHURCH

The Lord has blessed our little Kampong Thom church community with a vibrant and passionate young pastor, Ly Deth. We have been journeying alongside him for a few months and he is in the early stages of building relationships with the community, with a view to possibly stepping into a more permanent shepherding role.



We are already beginning to see the fruit of his regular teaching, with approximately 10 children attending discipleship classes every Saturday afternoon.

NEW DISCIPLESHIP SPACE IN CHHOUK VA MUOY

In our Chhouk Va Muoy community on the outskirts of Phnom Penh, the Lord has graciously provided a small rental house that will allow us to be more intentional and active in our ministry. This new space will serve as a base for outreach and discipleship, as well as a hub for our partners to join in sharing the gospel with the over 500 families living in the area.

Most of these families were displaced from various locations across Phnom Penh and beyond due to land development, leading to broken social ties, loss of income, and increased poverty, violence, and drug use. We believe that through faithful witness and discipleship, many will find hope in Christ, become disciples, and go on to transform this community.



LEARNING CENTRE IN CHHUK

Over the past six months, we have been seeking the Lord's guidance as we refocus on His vision and mission for the Learning Centre and church community in Chhuk, Kampot. Together with the local community, we are refining the Learning Centre to focus on providing discipleship and Khmer education exclusively to children unable to attend school in any capacity.



EDUCATIONAL SPONSORSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS



CHEA AND POVLEAK WITH BRAVE MINISTRY STAFF

Since its inception, BRAVE has focused on equipping and empowering youth to break the cycle of poverty through education and vocational training, and has supported over a dozen young people through sponsorships and scholarships.

We currently support two university students: Povleak, in his first year of mechanical engineering, and Puthida, in her third year of Linguistics and Translation.

Chea, who has been supported by BRAVE for the past three years, has just graduated from high school and is currently preparing for his Bible College entrance examination.

SPONSORSHIPS FOR DRUG CORRECTION CENTRE STUDENTS

We also continue to support our partner, Ps Ratha, at the Drug Correction Centre in Siem Reap by sponsoring graduates from the Basic Electrical Skills course.

We provide the top two graduates with a fully equipped 'Small Business Toolbox', to help them build a sustainable income upon release, and give them the hope of breaking free from the destructive cycle of drug addiction and related crime.

Over the past two years, a generous sponsor has enabled us to provide Toolboxes to twelve young men and women.

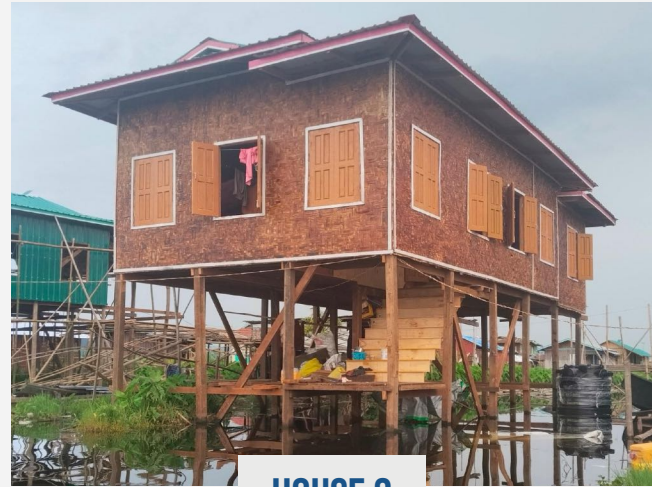

By God's grace and with the kind support of donors, we have completed the rebuilding of 5 houses for families who lost their homes in the earthquake crisis at Kay Lar Village.



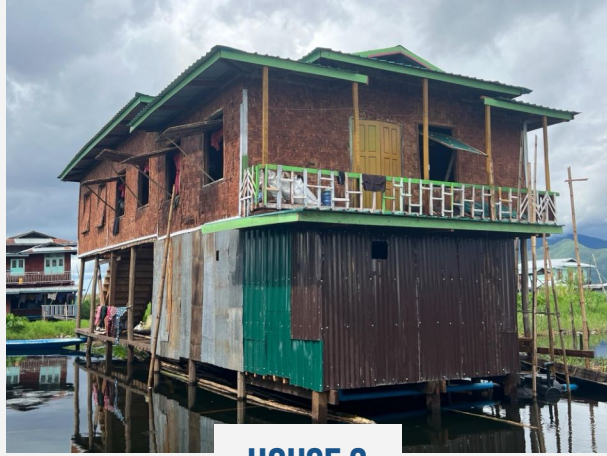

We deeply value your partnership as we build BRAVE Singapore to serve as an oversight and support for Cambodia, Myanmar, and beyond. In the last two months, we have been focused on three key areas:

STRENGTHENING LEADERS

Our heart has been to support and equip the country directors and key leaders of Brave Myanmar & Brave Cambodia, spending time to train and journey with them.

MEETING PRACTICAL NEEDS

In August and September, we helped raise funds for a much-needed water filtration system in Myanmar, ensuring that families and communities have access to safe drinking water.

BUILDING GOVERNANCE

We have been meeting with our Board Chairperson and Spiritual Oversight to uphold accountability and maintain alignment. Much time has also been invested into drafting the Constitution and attending to compliance matters.

At present, we are awaiting ACRA's approval for incorporation as a Company Limited by Guarantee, which will strengthen our structure and transparency.

PREACHING, WORKSHOP AND MEETINGS WITH LEADERS

In September, we had the privilege of serving in Cambodia. Ps Samuel preached at Nations Church across two services, bringing a message from the book of Joel on God's promise to restore lost years. Alongside this, we conducted an Intentional Discipleship Workshop for more than 20 pastors and leaders representing New Life Fellowship Church, Nations Church, Iris (NGO), BRAVE Cambodia, and several independent provincial churches.

We were also joined by our Board Chairman, Carol Chong, who provided oversight during the trip. She attended key meetings with leaders and offered valuable counsel on ministry matters, strengthening the governance and direction of our work in Cambodia.
