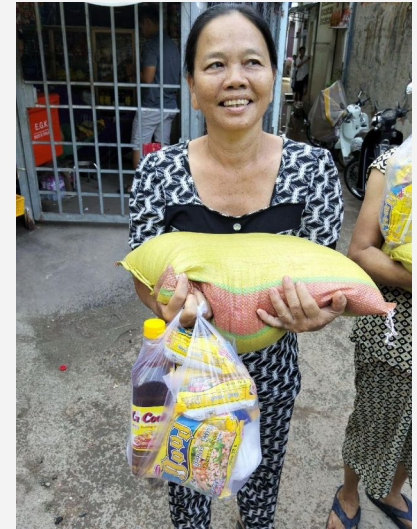

BRAVE OUTREACH

Since October our team has reached out to approximately 140 families and almost 600 individuals in need. Through the Lord's incredible provision, we have been able to bless these impoverished families with much needed rice, staple food items, baby milk formula and medicine.

Whilst we have nourished their bodies with more than 1000 kgs of rice, more importantly every family has received a Gospel booklet and heard the good news of Jesus.



EDUCATING THE NEXT GENERATION

BRAVE currently supports more than 60 children and young people at various stages in their education. We have 36 early learning and primary aged children attending our Learning Centre in the south of Cambodia. This Centre is exclusively committed to providing essential education and spiritual development to children who are unable to participate in the local school system due to geographical, financial or logistical challenges. We have two incredible part-time teachers who hold two classes from 9-12am, 6 days per week, followed by sports and craft related activities.



RAISING FAITHFUL LEADERS



Every week our shepherds and leaders gather on line to study God's word and challenge and equip one another. Currently we have up to 10 leaders joining every Wednesday evening, reliable internet permitting! These shepherds and leaders continue to grow together, glean from one another and take what they learn back to their churches and discipleship groups. They also actively encourage one another with prayer, wisdom and practical support through a dedicated group chat. In 2026, our hope is to hold two larger shepherds gatherings to minister to, encourage and equip our network of leaders from across the country.

HOPE WITHIN THE PRISON WALLS



After months of prayer and waiting on the Lord's timing, we were granted permission in October to begin a discipleship class for English-speaking women at the Phnom Penh Women's Correctional Centre. Each Monday afternoon, we spend time with around 14 women from diverse nations, gathering to study God's Word and encourage one another in faith.

While many had encountered Jesus before, their testimonies reveal a powerful truth, summed up by one woman who shared, *"Outside I was a prisoner, but inside this prison Jesus met me and set me free."* In the midst of very challenging circumstances, these women demonstrate deep faith, boldly sharing Christ with others around them.

We pray that this group will continue to grow in both number and depth, and that in time, God may open the door for a Khmer discipleship class as well.

BRAVE CAMBODIA CHRISTMAS OUTREACH

This Christmas, our team shared the hope and joy of Jesus across multiple communities.



At our Learning Centre in Chhuk, we celebrated Christ's birth with students, teachers, and community leaders through a Christmas message, gifts, and a fellowship meal.

In the urban slums, we visited displaced Vietnamese families, bringing the Gospel, prayer, and food packs.

We also had the privilege of sharing worship, lunch, and gifts with English-speaking women in the Women's Prison, proclaiming the freedom found in Christ.

In Chouk Va Mouy, believers and community members gathered to worship, hear the message of Jesus, and enjoy fellowship over a shared meal.



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In Myanmar, we are grateful to share that the team successfully completed 14 Christmas outreaches across various communities. Over the past few months, our local team worked tirelessly to prepare the ground - coordinating logistics, planning programmes, and organising gifts so that each outreach could be carried out with care, excellence, and love. Through these efforts, many were reached with practical support and the hope of the Gospel.

CHRISTMAS OUTREACH TO EARTHQUAKE AFFECTED COMMUNITIES

Between 2–12 December, our team carried out seven Christmas outreaches among earthquake-affected communities across several villages, reaching hundreds of people living in fragile and often forgotten conditions. Despite challenges such as limited space, remote locations, and communities with past resistance to the Gospel, each outreach was conducted peacefully and received with openness.



CHRISTMAS OUTREACH TO EARTHQUAKE AFFECTED COMMUNITIES



Through Christmas songs, drama, Gospel sharing, prayer, and fellowship, we witnessed hearts soften, joy replace sorrow, and hope take root. From villages hearing the Christmas message for the first time, to places where faith had long been suppressed or once rejected, God's presence was evident - affirming that no seed sown is ever wasted, and that His love continues to bring healing, restoration, and renewed openness even in the midst of hardship.



PRISON AND REFUGEE OUTREACH

Our team also reached out to prisoners, their families, and refugee communities, bringing the comfort and hope of Christmas to those often forgotten. We held a small, personal gathering for families of incarcerated loved ones, offering prayer, encouragement, and gifts as we listened to their burdens and shared in their tears and renewed hope.

Later in the month, we welcomed 150 refugee families from three camps to a safe location for fellowship, prayer and practical support, reminding them that God sees them and has not forgotten them.

PRISON AND REFUGEE OUTREACH



By God's grace, we also carried out a Prisoners' Christmas Outreach, preparing and distributing 500 Christmas gift sets for female prisoners and sharing the Gospel through prayer and encouragement within the prison. Though no photos could be taken, we are deeply encouraged by how the Lord continues to open doors for ministry in these difficult places.

COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS OUTREACH

Our team carried out community Christmas outreaches across homes, schools, public spaces, and communities, reaching children, families, leaders, and over 1,500 people. From intimate gatherings at Joy Home and the Grace Preschool & Grace Home, where children and families experienced joy, encouragement, and care, to an unprecedented Christmas carol outreach that opened doors into government offices, hospitals, police stations, and community leaders' homes, the Gospel was shared widely through worship, prayer, and fellowship.



COMMUNITY CHRISTMAS OUTREACH



We culminated the season with a Christmas Big Event on 25 December, welcoming people from diverse backgrounds with performances, gifts, and the clear message of Christ's love. Across every outreach, relationships were strengthened, practical needs were met, and seeds of hope and faith were planted for lasting impact.



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SINGAPORE

We deeply value your partnership as we build BRAVE Singapore to serve as an oversight and support for Cambodia, Myanmar, and beyond. In the last 3 months, we have been focused on 3 key areas:

STRENGTHENING LEADERS

We are meeting more regularly with our Country Directors to encourage, pray, and walk closely with them, strengthening leadership and ensuring alignment in vision, values, and mission as they serve their communities.

BUILDING FRAMEWORK

We are building our discipleship framework, ensuring our work remains biblically grounded as we serve communities through compassion and discipleship.

GOVERNANCE & ACCOUNTABILITY

We are currently establishing key governance and operational structures while awaiting approval for BRAVE Singapore. This season of preparation is an important step toward accountability, sustainability, and long-term impact.

MEETINGS WITH COUNTRY DIRECTORS AND TEAM

In November, we had the privilege of spending a meaningful day in Singapore with Pastor Gideon, coming together for prayer, fellowship, and ministry alignment. It was a life-giving time of encouragement and unity in Christ.

In December, we travelled to Cambodia to connect with our on-ground team and country directors, strengthening relationships and praying into the next season of ministry.



PREACHING AT NATIONS CHURCH AND KUM YAN METHODIST

During the trip to Cambodia, Pastor Samuel had the privilege of preaching at Nations Church from John 1:29–42, calling Believers and Non-Believers to “Come And See Jesus For Yourselfes”



He was also invited to minister at Kum Yan Methodist Church, where he shared a Christmas evangelistic message on “Jesus-The Hope That Never Fails.”

These moments were a timely reminder that even as organisational processes continue, the work of the Gospel is moving forward.
